- 18 Keep in a sanitary manner for children beds and its clothing (identified and separated for each child; the side of the bed in contact with the floor must not be in contact with the side where the child sleep or each side of the mattress need to be sanitized daily).
- 19 Keep out of the reach of the children any kind of chemicals (cleaners, insecticides, deodorizers, even the spray to clean the white board) currently available (classrooms 28, 25, 17, 136, 132, 71, 81, B013A, B012B, etc).
- 1 Clean old roaches droppings in cabinets (classroom 71, etc).
